PTA Financial Update – Tully Fletcher (Treasurer)

- The budget was presented, and it will also be available on the PTA website.
- Total expected revenue is around \$43K most funding (\$28K) comes from Drew CARES (formerly the Drew Opportunity Fund)
- The PTA started the year with approximately \$9K, and we anticipate breaking even at the end of the year.
- Parents were encouraged to send donations to Drew CARES. Some fundraising directly supports the PTA like the Drew Dads event coming up.
- The PTA budget was approved unanimously. Then we heard Golden by Ms. Harris and Mr. Peay, followed by Stand Up for Love by the EA Chorus. Amazing performances!

Drew CARES Update - Arlissa Williams-Jennings

- Drew CARES is our new process for fundraising for Drew, and it replaces activity fees.

Drew Strategic Plan Update – Charisse Richardson (Drew Chief of Staff)

- Created a new five year plan with Bellwether.
- Drew Graduate Profile is designed for our scholars a statement/vision of the things we want students to have when they finish 12th grade, starting with preK. It includes basic skills, habits, and mindsets. Want at least 75% of students to embody the graduate profile (hopefully closer to 100%).
- Five year intended impact by 2030, Drew's intended impact will focus on the community, students, staff, and families. Goal is to engage with families, including the Villages of East Lake and the broader community.
- Four strategic priority areas include vision of school culture that fosters a consistent experience of belonging and excellence; clarify academic program design, expectations, and accountability; intentionally engage caregivers and community; and, codify a talent strategy focused on recruitment, retention, and effectiveness.
- Drew has initiated a survey to get information on key competencies to create Drew's Graduate
